Dr. Caroline Robinson is the Associate Organist-Choirmaster at the Cathedral of St. Philip (Episcopal) in Atlanta. She holds degrees from the Curtis Institute of Music and the Eastman School of Music. She also studied in Toulouse, France as a Fulbright fellow. She has performed at a number of important venues, including St. Thomas Church, Fifth Avenue in New York City and The Memorial Church at Harvard. She also won second prize in the prestigious biannual National Young Artists Competition in Organ Performance in 2018.
